ABOUT LAKE ATITLAN

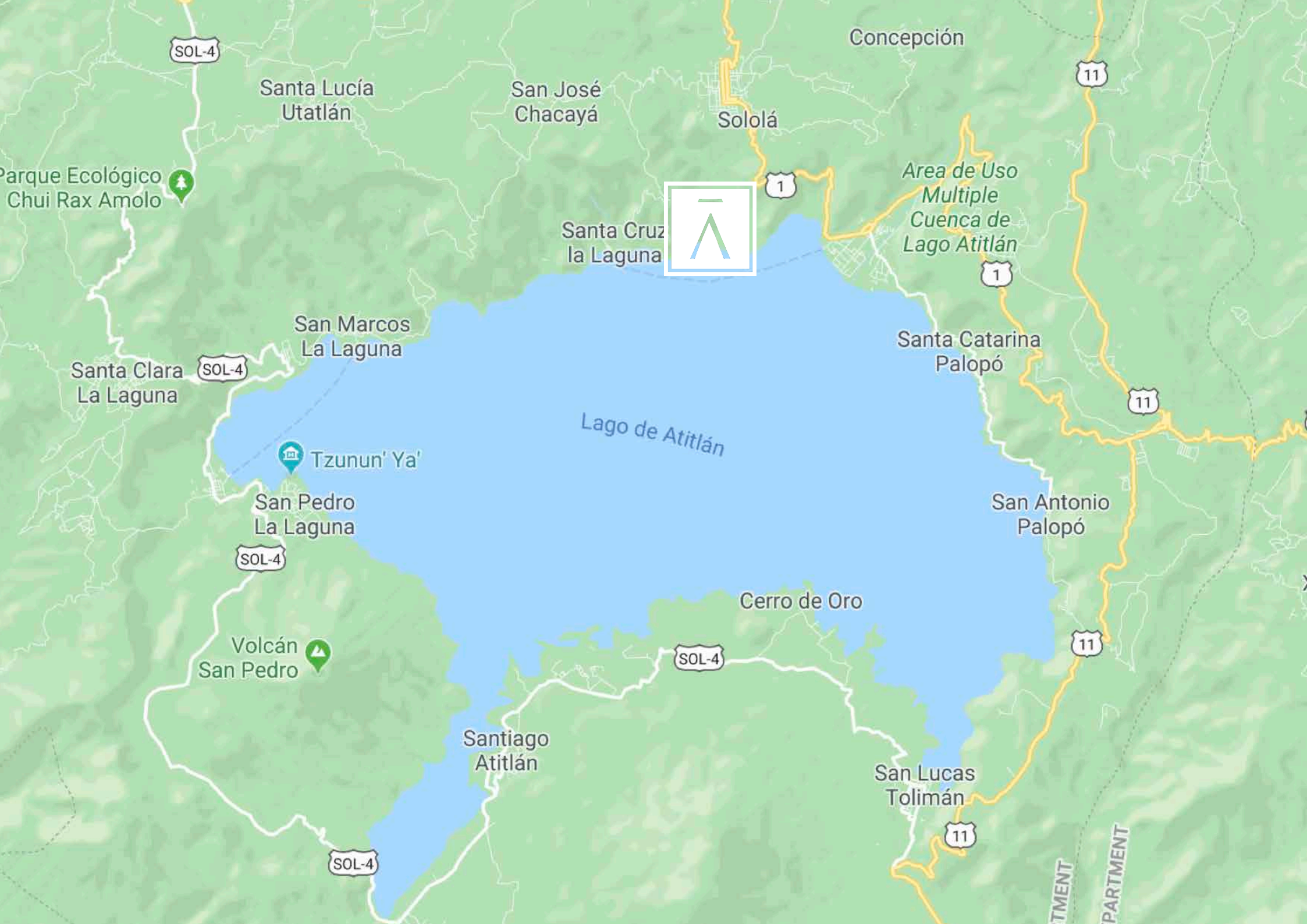
Lake Atitlan renowned as one of the most beautiful lakes in the world, and one of Guatemala's most important national and international tourist attraction, is located 140 Kms away from Guatemala City, in the Guatemalan mountains of the Sierra Madre, at an altitude of 1,550 meters. Atitlan means "in the water" in Nahuatl. Its average depth is 220 meters and the surface area is 130 km², approximately 18 by 8 km.

The basin of the lake is of volcanic origin, filling an enormous caldera formed by an eruption 84,000 years ago. On its banks rise the extinct volcanoes Atitlan (3,537 m), Tolimán (3,158 m) and San Pedro (3,020 m).

The proximity to the equator provides a spring-like climate all year round. The days are warm and sunny on most mornings and cooler and sometimes cloudy in the afternoon. The dry season typically runs from November to May.

Lake Atitlan is the most important spiritual and healing center in Guatemala for more than 2000 years. The lake has been inhabited since at least 300 BC. The culture of the towns and villages that surround Lake Atitlan is influenced by the Mayan people. Today the Mayans of Atitlan are predominantly Tz'utujil and Kaqchikel.





PAXANAX – THE MOST TRANQUIL BAY AT LAKE ATITLAN

Casa Prana is located next to the village of Santa Cruz La Laguna on the edge of Lake Atitlan.

The connection to the property is made only by boat through Panajachel, the main village in the area. The boat of Casa Prana picks and delivers the guests from and to Panajachel, on the arrival and departure days. It is also possible to reach the property through helicopter.

Travel time to Guatemala City is around 3 hours by car or 25 minutes by Helicopter.
